AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE A SUM OF ONE THOUSAND FIFTY MILLION FIVE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN THOUSAND SHILLINGS OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND TO THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING ON THE THIRTIETH DAY OF JUNE, ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY FIVE, TO AUTHORISE THE RE-ALLOCATION OF CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS AND TO PROVIDE FOR MATTERS INCIDENTAL THERETO AND CONNECTED THERETO.

ENACTED by the House of Representatives of Gambia.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1984.

2. The Treasury, Ministry of Finance, Gambia may issue out of the Consolidated Fund of the Revolutionary Government of Gambia for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1985 the sum of one thousand fifty million five hundred and seventeen thousand shillings.

3. The sum granted by section 2 of this Act shall be applied for the purposes and amounts specified in the Schedule of this Act.

Power of
Minister
to borrow.

4. (1) The Minister for Finance Gambia may at any time not later than the thirtieth day of June, 1985 borrow within or outside Gambia any sum or sums not exceeding the total sum granted or deemed to have been granted out of the Consolidated Fund under the provisions of section 2 of this Act by way of loan, advance, the issue of bills or bank overdraft and on such terms and conditions as the Minister may deem expedient, and may charge that loan or advance on any of the assets of Gambia (including securities forming part of the Consolidated Fund).

(2) Any money borrowed under this section shall be placed to the credit of the exchange account and shall form part of the Consolidated Fund, and be available in any manner in which that Fund is available.

(3) Any money borrowed under this section shall be subject to repayment not later than the thirtieth day of June, 1985 and any sum required for the payment of any money so borrowed, and of any interest payable in respect of that money shall be charged on and paid out of the Consolidated Fund.

(4) The powers conferred upon the Minister for Finance Kamilar under this section shall be in addition to the powers of the Minister under the Government Loans, Stocks and Grants Guarantee Decree, 1976.

5. (1) Where the Minister for Finance Kamilar is satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest that provision should be made for defraying the expenditure of any Ministry or Department of the Government in excess of any sum voted for it or for any service for which no sum is voted, and that it would be detrimental to the public interest to postpone the expenditure until provision can be made for it by the House of Representatives, he may notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in this Act or any other written law, authorise the application of any surplus arising on any vote in the Schedule to this Act, for or towards the excess or service.

(2) Where the Minister for Finance authorise the application of any surplus under this section, he shall as soon as practicable after authorisation cause to be laid before the House of Representatives a supplementary estimate or a statement or re-allocation, as the case may be in accordance with the provisions of section 65 of the Kamilar Constitution, 1979.

(3) The Minister of Finance may delegate all or any of the powers conferred upon him by this section to any public officer subject to such limitations as the Minister may specify.
