## AN ACT TO AMEND THE ZANZIBAR CONSTITUTION, 1984

ENACTED by the House of Representatives of Zanzibar.

Short title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Zanzibar
Constitution Fourth Amendment Act of 1991 shall be read
together with the constitution and shall come into operation
immediately upon being assented by the President.

Interpretation.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires:

"Executive Committee" means the Party National Executive Committee.

"Constitution" means the Zanzibar Constitution
1984.

"Special Committee" means the Special Committee
of National Executive Committee established
under the provision of section 75(10) of the
Party Constitution which will coordinate
the party's activities in Zanzibar,
Government.



"Party" means Chama cha Mapinduzi.

Amendment of section 32.

- 3. Section 32 of the Constitution is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (c) of subsection (2) and replacing the following new paragraph:-
  - "(c) The Chief Justice shall confirm to the best of his knowledge that the President is unable to exercise his duties as a result of physical or mental infirmity and submit a Certificate to confirm such incapacity to the special committee which shall receive such certificate and give their recommendations and forward it to the Central Committee of National Executive Committee which shall refer the same to National Executive Committee for its final decision."

Amendment of section 34.

- 4. Section 34 of the Constitution is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (a) of subsection (2) and replacing the following new paragraph:-
  - "(a) When occasion arises for election of the President subject to the provisions of subsection (1) of this section the special committee shall nominate and scrutinise the names of Zanzibaris for the Zanzibar Presidential candidate and recommend a name of qualified Zanzibari a sole candidate to Central Committee which shall recommend the name of the said Zanzibari to the National Executive Committee."

Amendment of section 128.

5. Section 128 of the Constitution is hereby amended by deleting subsection (3) and inserting the following new subsection:-



"(3) A resignation notice by the President shall be tendered to the special committee which shall submit such notice to the Central Committee which shall further forward it to the National Executive Committee for its approval."

Passed in the House of Representatives on the 2nd day of October, 1991.
