AN ACT TO AMEND THE SPECIAL DEPARTMENTS SERVICE COMMISSION ACT, NO.7 OF 1986.

ENACTED by the House of Representatives of Zanzibar.

Short title and commencement.

- 1.(1) This Act may be cited as the Special
 Departments Service Commission (Amendment) Act, 1993
 and shall be read together with the Special Departments
 Service Commission Act, No.7 of 1986 which is hereinafter
 referred to as the principal Act.
- (2) This Act shall come into operation after being assented to by the President.

Amendment of section 2.

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the phrases "subordinate officer" and "superior officer" appearing in that section and in any other section in the Act and substituting for them the phrases "junior officer" and "senior officer" respectively.



Amendment of section

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the phrase "under paragraphs (d) and (e)" appearing in that section and substituting for it the phrase "under paragraphs (c), (d) and (e)".

Amendment of section 6.

- 4. Section 6 of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (3) immediately after subsection (2) as follows:-
 - "(3) The Commission may delegate its powers relating to the recruitments, disciplinary measures and promotions of ranks to the commanding officers".

Amendment of section 13.

- 5. Section 13 of the principal Act is hereby amended by -
 - (a) deleting subsection (1) thereof and substituting for the following:-
 - "(1) An appeal shall lie to the President of Zanzibar who is the Chief Commander to Special Departments of SMZ from any decision of the Commission to exercise disciplinary control or remove from office any such person who is aggrieved of the Commission's decision."
 - (b) deleting the marginal note thereof and replacing for the following:-

"Appeal to the President".
