AN ACT TO AMEND THE PENSIONS  
(POLITICAL APPOINTEES) ACT, NO.1 OF 1990

ENACTED by the House of Representatives of  
Zanzibar.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions  
(Political Appointees) (Amendment) Act, 1995 and shall  
be read together with the Pension (Political Appointees)  
Act, No.1 of 1990 hereinafter referred to as the principal  
Act.

Repeal and  
replacement  
of section 4.

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is hereby  
repealed and replaced by the following:-

"Computation.

4(1) A gratuity granted under this Act  
shall be computed at the rate of hundred per centum (100%)  
of his last salary for the years of his qualifying service.

(2) Fifty per centum (50%) of the whole  
amount shall be paid to the political appointee as gratuity  
while the remaining fifty per centum (50%) shall be spread  
over and paid monthly as pension."

Repeal and  
replacement  
of section 5.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is hereby  
repealed and replaced by the following:-

"Entitlement  
to pension.

5.(1) A pension calculated in accordance with the provision of section 4(2) of this Act shall be granted to a political appointee who has completed ten years or more of qualifying service and such pension shall be payable to him for the rest of his life time.

(2) In addition to the gratuity and pension payable under this section any political appointee shall be entitled to receive other allowances and services as is indicated in the Schedule to this Act."

#### SCHEDULE

#### DESCRIPTION OF ALLOWANCES AND SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO A POLITICAL APPOINTEE

- (i) Government House or 35% of his last salary paid monthly as house allowance.
- (ii) Electricity allowance at the rate of 25% of his last salary paid monthly.
- (iii) Transport allowance at the rate of 25% of his last salary paid monthly.
- (iv) Diplomatic passport.
