AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED AND FOURTY FOUR BILLIONS, SIX HUNDRED AND THIRTY EIGHT MILLION, TWO HUNDRED AND SIX THOUSAND SHILLINGS OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND TO THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING ON THE THIRTIETH DAY OF JUNE, TWO THOUSAND AND ELEVEN, TO AUTHORISE THE REALLOCATION OF CERTAIN APPROPRIATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR MATTERS INCIDENTAL THERETO AND CONNECTED THEREWITH

ENACTED by the House of Representatives of Zanzibar.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act of 2010.

2. The Treasury in the Ministry of Finance Zanzibar, may issue out of the Shillings Consolidated Fund of the Revolutionary Government of Zanzibar for the service of 444,638,206,000 the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 2011 the sum of Four Hundred and Fourty Four Billions, Six Hundred and Thirty Eight Million, Two Hundred and Six Thousand Shillings.

Appropriation of moneys voted.

 The sum granted under section 2 of this Act, shall be applied for the purposes and amounts specified in the Schedules of this Act.

Power of the Minister to borrow. 4.(1) The Minister for Finance Zanzibar, may at any time not later than the thirtieth day of June, 2011, borrow within or outside Zanzibar any sum not exceeding the total sum granted or deemed to have been granted out of the Consolidated



Fund under the provisions of section 2 of this Act, by way of loan, advance, issue of bills or bank over draft and on such terms and conditions as the Minister may deem expedient, and may charge that loan or advance on any of the assets of Zanzibar (including securities forming part of the Consolidated Fund).

- (2) Any money borrowed under sub section (1) of this section, shall be placed to the credit of the exchequer account and shall form part of the Consolidated Fund and be available in any manner in which that fund is available.
- (3) Any money borrowed under sub section (1) of this section, shall be subject to repayment not later than the thirtieth day of June, 2011 and any sum required for the repayment of any money so borrowed, and of any interest payable in respect of that money shall be charged on and paid out of the Consolidated Fund.
- (4) The power conferred upon the Minister for Finance under sub section (1) of this section, shall be in addition to the powers of the Minister under the Government Loans, Stock and Grants Decree, No. 5 of 1978.

Power of the Minister to reallocate certain appropriated moneys.

- 5.(1) Where the Minister for Finance Zanzibar is satisfied that it is necessary in the public interest, provision should be made for defraying the expenditure of any Ministry or Department of the Government in excess of any sum voted for it or for any service for which no sum is voted, and that it would be detrimental to the public interest to postpone the expenditure until provision can be made for it by the House of Representatives, he may, notwithstanding with any provision in this Act or any other written law, authorize the application of any surplus on any vote in the Schedules to this Act for or towards the excess or service.
- (2) Where the Minister for Finance, authorises the application of any surplus under sub section (1) of this section, he shall, as soon as practicable after authorization, cause to be laid before the House of Representatives a Supplementary Estimate of a statement of re-allocation as the case may be, in accordance with the provisions of section 106(2) of the Constitution of Zanzibar of 1984, if such re-allocation results in a surplus expenditure.



(3) The Minister for Finance may delegate all or any of the power conferred upon him under sub section (1) of this section, to any public officer subject to such limitations as the Minister may specify.

Redemption and payment of interests. **6.** The sum required from time to time for public Loans redemption and repayments of interests in respect of 2010/2011 (Tsh. 3,000,000,000/=) hereby charged shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund.

Approval of development plans.

7. The development plans indicated in schedule II are hereby approved for the year 2010/2011.

Approval of moneys votes and / or granted for development expenditure.

8. The sum granted in accordance with section 2 of this Act, is hereby approved for development expenditure as indicated in schedule III thereof and shall be applied for the purposes and amounts specified in the Schedules of this Act.
