AN ACT TO REPEAL THE ZANZIBAR JOURNALISM AND MASS MEDIA COLLEGE ACT, NO. 11 OF 2006

ENACTED by the House of Representatives of Zanzibar.

PART ONE PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

Short title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Act to Repeal the Zanzibar Journalism and Mass Media College Act, No. 11 of 2006, and shall come into operation immediately after being assented to by the President.

Interpretation.

2. In this Act, unless the context requires otherwise:

"College" means the Zanzibar Journalism and Mass Media College;

"President" means the President of Zanzibar and Chairman of the Revolutionary Council;

"repealed Act" means the Zanzibar Journalism and Mass Media College Act, No. 11 of 2006.



PART TWO REPEAL AND SAVING PROVISIONS

Repeal and saving.

- **3.-**(1) The Zanzibar Journalism and Media College Act, No. 11 of 2006 is hereby repealed.
 - (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of repeal under subsection (1) of this section:
 - (a) appointments, regulations, orders or any other acts made or done under the repealed Act prior to the commencement of this Act shall remain effective and in force unless they are amended, revoked or replaced under the provisions of the State University of Zanzibar Act, No. 8 of 1999;
 - (b) all students admitted in accordance with the admission regulations of the College made under the repealed Act shall graduate and conferred with certificates bearing names of the College according to the repealed Act and its regulations; and
 - (c) the current employees of the College shall continue to execute their duties under the provisions of the State University of Zanzibar Act, No. 8 of 1999 and the Public Service Act, No. 2 of 2011.
